**Study topic:** *The Vision of His Glory: Finding Hope Through the Revelation of Jesus Christ, by Anne Graham Lotz* ----- Without question, we are living in a rapidly changing world. The book of Revelation was written to help Christians who are experiencing pressure and problems, stress and suffering, crisis and change, to keep their focus on Jesus at such a time as this.
