**Awake, awake, Zion, clothe** yourself with strength! Put on your **garments of splendor, Jerusalem, the holy city.** The uncircumcised and **defiled** will not **enter** you **again.** **Shake** off your **dust; rise** up, sit enthroned, **Jerusalem.** Free yourself from the chains on your neck, Daughter **Zion,** now a captive. For this is what

the **LORD** says: "You were sold for **nothing**, and without money you will be **redeemed.**" For this is what the Sovereign **LORD** says: "At first my **people** went down to Egypt to live; lately, Assyria has oppressed them. "And now what do I have here?" **declares** the **LORD.** "For my **people** have been taken away for **nothing**, and those who rule them mock," **declares** the **LORD.** "And all day long my **name** is constantly blasphemed. **Therefore** my **people** will **know** my **name**; **therefore** in that day they will **know** that it is I who foretold it. Yes, it is I." How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who **bring good** news, who **proclaim** peace, who **bring good** tidings, who **proclaim salvation**, who say to **Zion**, "Your God reigns!" Listen! Your watchmen lift up their voices; **together** they shout for joy. When the **LORD** returns to **Zion**, they will see it with their own eyes. Burst into songs of joy **together**, you ruins of **Jerusalem**, for the **LORD** has comforted his **people**, he has **redeemed Jerusalem.** The **LORD** will lay bare his **holy** arm in the sight of all the nations, and all the ends of the earth will see the **salvation** of our God.
